

ORDINANCE NO. 41
ORDINANCE REQUIRING CONTRACTORS HIRED BY
OR CONTRACTING WITH SOUTH SUBURBAN
SANITARY DISTRICT TO ABIDE BY ALL
FEDERAL AND STATE LAWS AND REGULATIONS

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of South Suburban Sanitary District (hereinafter "the District") have determined that any contractors hired by or contracting with the District must comply with all federal, state, and local statutes, laws, ordinances and administrative rules, and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the District note that no ordinance exists requiring contractors who are hired by or contracting with the District to abide by said laws and rules, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the District does by Resolution and Ordinance and Order, ordain as follows:

1. All contractors, whether public or private, hired by or contracting with the District shall abide by all federal, state, and local statutes, laws, ordinances and administrative rules.

2. This Ordinance shall include but not be limited to all United States Code Sections, CFR's, treasury regulations, prevailing wage statutes, Oregon Revised Statutes, Oregon Administrative Rules, Oregon Construction Contractor Board Rules and Administrative regulations, Klamath County Building codes and ordinances and resolutions of the District.

3. All such contractors must also follow all Oregon OSHA rules and regulations.

4. Upon request by the District manager, all contractors must file reports, documentation and evidence confirming their compliance with all above-noted rules, statutes and regulations.

5. Should the manager, in its discretion, reasonably believe that a contractor hired by or contracting with the District has failed to comply with any of the above-mentioned rules, regulations or statutes, the manager may direct a cease and desist order to said contractor until the contractor has met the manager's compliance requests.

6. Any contractor receiving such a cease and desist order from the manager of the District, may appeal the manager's decision to the Board of Directors of the District, whose decision shall be final and binding upon the contractor.

7. The Board of Directors of the District pass this Ordinance to ensure public health and safety requirements are met and to ensure that all contractors hired by or contracting with the District comply with all federal, state and local rules and regulations.
